- Colours can differ over years and from batch to batch.

- · Do not lean forewards or backwards, always stay on 4 feet.
- Stackable up to 8 pieces.
- Max. 1 person or 120 kg per seat.

- The stools are weatherproof, except for the version with oak seat.
- Do not stand on the stools.
- · Store the cushions indoor when not used.

# Powder-coating

- White powder-coating requires more maintenance.
- Do not use abrasive scouring powders or scourers as they will scratch the surface.
- · Colour can fade to some extent when exposed to UV. • Flame retarding - NEN-EN13501-1 A2-sl - Satisfying
- the same criteria as Class B for the SBI-test according to EN13823. In addition, under conditions of a fully developed fire these products will nog significantly contribute to the fire load and fire growth.
- · Dark colors can get very hot in sunny weather.

- When delivered, the wood is oiled.
- · Wood is a natural material and its look is different for every slat, plank and tree.
- Clean regularly with mild detergent. Never use a high pressure cleaner as this will roughen the wood's smooth surface and irreparably damage the wood's fiber.

- · Stains should be removed immediately with a clean, soft cloth, particularly in case of dark-coloured liquids such as wine, ink, coffee coke, oild and bird droppings. If left to dry, these liquids may cause permanent damage!
- Do not bleach to clean.

Q: Is it possible to stack the tiki?

A: It is possible. You can stack Tiki up to 8 pieces.

Q: Is the chair weatherproof?

A: Yes, except for the version with oak seat. The seat and legs of the Tiki stools are made of durable, UV- & waterproof materials. The hole in the seat makes sure the water can evacuate easily.

# Maintenance

Find maintenance instructions at the downloads section of extremis.com for:

### POWDER-COATED PARTS

- White powder-coating obviously requires more maintenance.
- · Clean stains with a magic eraser.

### FELT CUSHIONS

- Hand-wash in lukewarm water, please don't squeeze but spread them out
- Use a mild detergent and don't bleach, pleae also don't remove stains with aggressive chemicals but mild detergents.

### Good to know

- · Transparant fine lines, to give bars, kitchens, etc., a tidy, sleek look with its minimal impact.
- Foot rest with great freedom of movement.
- Water draining seat for powder-coated seats.
- Stackable up to 8 pieces.
